# Ethnography is...

Study of people and their behaviors



# The study of "other" or "primitive" or "exotic" cultures










- Humans: past and present
- Culture
- Acquired knowledge: interpret experiences and generate social experience
- Ethos (often tacit)
- Their point of view example of groups:
  - · community, village, neighborhood,
  - · organization, a work unit, network or group

...that shares a common experience (i.e., living with a chronic condition or medical experience)

# What is Ethnography

#### Spradley, 1979



- Culture is the way people make meaning of their experiences and operate in everyday life.
- Collective cognitive constructions that shape beliefs/attitudes and underlie behavior

# Ethnography

### FIELD EXPERIENCE

### **Participant Observation**

Role	Description	Use
Observer	Researcher is physically and psychological absent	Inappropriate for ethnographic study; may be used for other forms of qualitative research
Participant-Observer	Researcher creates role for the purpose of study	Typical role in ethnographic study
Interviewer	Establishes role with each person interviewed	Primarily used in ethnographic interview studies

Corroboration of field observations





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
