## ONE-DAY SEMINAR TO BE HELD AT TSC

There will be a one-day seminar on March 20 at TSC for area community and junior college counselors.

TSC academic deans and various staff personnel will meet with the counselors to review the academic progress of Tyler State and to project future programs.

The meeting will begin at 10 a.m. in the Conference Room and will be followed by a luncheon at Willowbrook Country Club.

The meeting will serve three purposes: (1) Review of the suggestions that were made at the last meeting and how they have been implemented; (2) Clarification of several suggestions that were made at the last meeting; and (3) Discuss new ideas and their feasibility.

## WORDSWORTH TO PRESENT PROGRAM

Richard Wordsworth, great great grandson of William Wordsworth, will present a one man program at Tyler State College on March 14 at 7:30 p.m.

Wordsworth's presentation, "The Bliss of Solitude," is a full evening show based on the life and works of his great great grandfather.

The program will be presented in the TSC Auditorium. It will include poetry from several of Wordsworth's poems.

The first part of the program will be an account of Wordsworth's early life from 1770 to 1800. It gives some indication of the debt the poet owed to his sister, Dorothy, and introduces other members of the Wordsworth circle.

The remainder of the program will include an account of Wordsworth and his circle in the nineteenth century including his life at Dove Cottage and Rydal Mount.

The Board will consider any and all business that may properly come before the meeting concerning the affairs of Tyler State College.

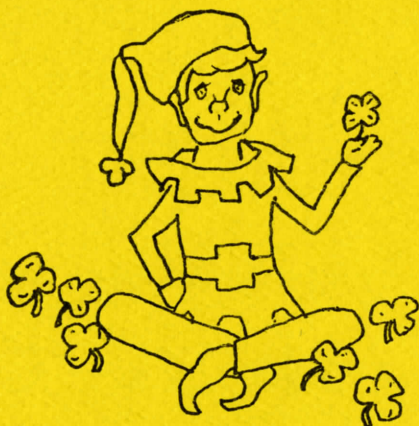


## TSC RESERVATIONS
