SHIPMENT OF CATALOGS IS DUE SOON

After several weeks of delay, the college has received 500 copies of the new 1974-75 catalog. Approximately 2,000 more catalogs were shipped Monday by way of a freight truck from Laredo.

The college has accepted only a partial shipment because of the poor quality of printing on the front cover. In fact, the catalogs accepted do not represent quality printing; however, the urgent need for them resulted in the acceptance of 2,500 copies.

The remainder of the order, approximately 2,500 catalogs, is presently being reprinted. It is anticipated that these will be shipped between June 1—15.

Regent David K. McKie of Tyler was appointed chairman of the newly organized committee, Special Committee for Gifts and Scholarships.

Dr. McVicker will also serve as chairman of the Executive Committee. Other regents who were appointed to serve on committees are Jack C. Morgan of Kaufman, H. J. Mc-Kenzie of Tyler, and Dean W. Turner of Henderson. All of the committee appointments are for one year.

Dr. McVicker said, "The college has moved far ahead of the originally proposed schedule, due to the citizenry of Tyler and the East Texas area, the dedicated support given to the college by state representatives, senators and the governor's office, the unselfish efforts of the TSC Educational Foundation, the around-the-clock work, enthusiasm and dedication of all the TSC Board of Regents, the leader-ship of the president, deans, faculty, and
