## BOARD OF REGENTS TO MEET WEDNESDAY

The annual meeting of the Tyler State College Board of Regents will be held at 2 p.m. Wednesday in the Conference Room.

Election of new officers for the board will highlight the meeting including the selection of a chairman, vice chairman and secretary.

Terms which are expiring include Chairman B. H. McVicker, M.D., Vice Chairman Dean W. Turner, and Secretary David K. McKie.

The board will also consider personnel additions and resignations, and the reappointment of Dr. James H. Stewart, Jr. as president of the college.

A report will be given by the Executive Committee relative to the election of new directors for the Tyler State College Educational Foundation, Inc. A report will also be given on the revised Bylaws of the Board of Regents of Tyler State College.

The Campus and Building Committee will present a report on Phase I construction. The President's Report and Recommendations will be presented by President Stewart.

The Department of Health and Physical Education at TSC will host the East Texas Regional Conference for Health Physical Education Recreation on April 11-12.


The conference entitled, "Cutting D-Pie," is being sponsored by the Texas Association for Health Physical Education Recreation (TAHPER) and Tyler State College.
