#### I. Regular Board of Regents Quarterly Meeting

As mentioned at the December 19, 1974 Board of Regents meeting in Kilgore, January 8, 1975 is the date for the regular quarterly meeting of the board. The agenda for this meeting will be placed in the mail tomorrow.

#### II. Opening of the Sixty-Fourth Legislative Session

The Sixty-Fourth Texas Legislature will convene on January 14, 1975. At the December 19, 1974 board meeting, discussion was conducted relative to the board making a special effort to be in Austin on this date in order to be present for both the Senate and House swearing in ceremonies and visit with legislators.
