## BOARD AUTHORIZES ARCHITECTS TO PREPARE BID PACKAGE AND SEEK COMPETITIVE BIDS

Architects were authorized by the Texas Eastern University board of regents at a March 17 meeting to prepare a separate bid package and seek competitive bids for the construction of the Health and Physical Education Building and related outdoor athletic and recreation facilities on the permanent TEU campus.

Funding for the proposed 26,000 square foot structure is through the \$1,750,000 combined fees revenue bond program.

A university mascot of "Patriots" was approved by the regents. The Mascot Advisory Committee received 101 nominations for the mascot name.

"The selection committee felt the name "Patriots" would be relatively unique and would avoid duplication of a mascot already used in Texas higher education," Dr. James H. Stewart, Jr. said of the selection. "Moreover, "Patriots" provide appeal and recognition both on state and national levels; one which will identify the university in a positive manner."

Dr. Stewart, who presented the recommendation to the regents, also announced the gift of a grand piano to the university from the estate of Mrs. Virginia E. Sutton. The piano will be delivered to the new campus this summer.

The regents approved a TEU contract with the University of Dallas Health Science Center for computer use for instructional purposes and accepted a donation of all air conditioning units presently used by TEU as a donation from the TEU Educational Foundation, Inc.
