## TEXAS EASTERN UNIVERSITY

#### 1978-79 BUDGET SUMMARY

The total budget for 1978-79, including Educational and General purposes, Designated Funds, Restricted Funds, Auxiliary Enterprises, Plant Expansion and Debt Service totals \$5,103,567.

Of the total amount, \$3,500,009 is budgeted for salaries and wages, \$1,458,925 for operating expenses, and \$144,633 for debt service.

The budget for Educational and General purposes, i.e., Instruction, Library, Operation of Physical Plant, Administration and Student Services totals \$4,584,701. This is an increase of \$351,807 or 8.3% from the 1977-78 budget for the same purposes.

The budget includes Designated Funds of \$21,350, \$333,266 for Auxiliary Enterprises, and Restricted Funds of \$19,617.

The net General Revenue Appropriation approved by the State legislature for the operation of Texas Eastern University is \$195,079 more for 1978-79 than was appropriated for the same purposes for 1977-78. Included in this total is a supplemental appropriation of \$57,076 which Texas Eastern University received from the Coordinating Board, Texas College and University System, Contingency Fund for Growth, because the university's 1977 fall semester full-time student equivalent enrollment (FTSE) was more than 10% above the actual Fall 1976 FTSE enrollment.
