1. Small Class Report

REPORT: In compliance with legislation enacted by the 65th Texas Legislature requiring all general academic institutions to submit a Small Class Report for authorization by respective governing boards each fall and spring semester, information on small classes being conducted by Texas Eastern University during the 1979 Summer II Term was mailed to you with Administrative Notes for August 6, 1979 and will be made a part of the official record of the university as an attachment to the minutes of this meeting. As defined by law, small classes include all organized undergraduate courses with enrollments of less than ten students and all organized graduate courses with less than five students, and I hereby recommend that the courses identified in the 1979 Summer II Term report be approved and authorized by the Board of Regents.
