### CONSTRUCTION PROGRESS REPORT PHASE II Week Ending: April 13, 1979

SCIENCE/MATH:

An electrical/mechanical punch list was completed by the architect's representative during the week. The contractor is working a preliminary architectural punch list previously completed. The second floor link with the existing HPR Building has been carpeted. Work remaining includes some stainless steel casework, placement of two pieces of terrazzo, cleanup, etc.

BUSINESS:

Sanding of tape and bedding work is in progress on the first floor. Tile work is progressing well in all four restrooms. Carpet is being laid in second floor classrooms. The second floor drywalls have been textured and painted. Electricians continue their rough-in work. Many electrical overhead light fixtures have been connected and are operational. Johnson pneumatic control work is over 95 percent complete.

SITEWORK:

The sidewalk from the Business Building west entrance to Parking Area 9 has been poured. Grading of the borrow area continues.
